

Charity Re-use Schemes

We work in partnership with furniture re-use charities at several sites around the County.

Bulky furniture that is in good condition is stored separately within the site and collected by local re-use charities for refurbishment and sale to the disadvantaged.

This has also helped to boost our recycling rates and provide people with the opportunity to benefit from other people's waste.

Other Re-use Options

At all of our other recycling centres re-usable items are stored in a locked container before being taken away for re-sale off site. This may be at car boot sales or auction houses.

Re-use Shelters

Norfolk County Council operates five Re-use Shelters at Recycling Centres across the County. The Re-use Shelters allow you to purchase desirable re-usable items for a small charge (similar to car boot prices).

Not only does this help to divert more waste from landfill and reduce disposal costs, but you might even be able to find a bargain! Proceeds from re-use sales are split between the Council, our contractor and local charities.

Re-use code of conduct:

- All items are sold as seen.
- All items are non-refundable.
- All marked prices are non-negotiable.
- If you would like to see any bulky items or large furniture please ask a Recycling Advisor.

What types of things can be purchased?

- ✓ Bric-a-brac
- ✓ Books
- ✓ Videos/CDs/DVDs /LPs
- ✓ Pictures/Frames
- ✓ Small Furniture
- ✓ Toys
- ✓ Mirrors
- ✓ Sports equipment

What types of things can't be purchased?

- ✗ Any electrical items (as these need to be PAT tested)
- ✗ Any hazardous items
- ✗ Childrens toys for children under the age of three
